## Gentlemen:

This letter constitutes the initial written report concerning the subject condition initially reported to the Commission under the requirements of 10CFR50.55(e) on January 4, 1983 as a potentially reportable deficiency.

Some Electrical Equipment panels have not been mounted as prescribed by the mounting arrangement drawings. This condition has been identified in the control room and switchgear rooms.

Henry J. Kaiser and Cincinnati Gas & Electric are evaluating the panel mounting welds to imbed plates and the as-built mounting arrangements. All other electrical equipment panels are being examined to identify if additional panels do not conform to the mounting requirements. To date, ten (10) panels have been identified that are not in conformance with design requirements. Each panel not found in conformance with the design requirements is being documented on nonconformance reports for evaluation or rework as required. Examination of all panels is expected to be completed by March 31, 1983, at which time a final report will be submitted.
