SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION DATED NOVEMBER 2, 1993

This acknowledges receipt of your letters dated November 18, 1993 and January 16, 1994, in response to our letter dated November 2, 1993, transmitting a Notice of Violation.

This also refers to the telephone conversation between Mr. Fred Blizzard of your staff and Mr. J. L. Cameron of this office on February 3, 1994, regarding your responses to the Notice of Violation. Based on that conversation, our understanding of your corrective actions for Violation A include the performance of both ambient radiation and removable contamination level surveys by your radiation safety officer in all patient diagnostic areas monthly and in all research areas quarterly. Furthermore, our understanding of your response to our concern regarding the lack of a formalized radiation safety program audit procedure includes the performance of routine compliance audits of all radioactive material uses on a quarterly basis. The purpose of those audits is to evaluate the effectiveness of your radiation safety program.

Your corrective actions for the other violations identified appear to be adequate, and we have no further questions at this time. These corrective actions will be examined during a future inspection.
