Subject: Supplemental Response to Inspection Nos. 50-443/82-04 and 50-444/82-04

Dear Sir:

We wish to report that the following corrective action is being taken in addition to that reported to you in Reference (c) and discussed in Reference (d):

- UE&C has been directed to expand their existing system regarding the distribution of controlled documents to assure that manufacturers instructions/manuals are forwarded to at least the prime installation contractor.
- Site contractors have been instructed to review the appropriate instruction manuals to extract pertinent information, and to incorporate such information into their own installation/inspection instructions.
- 3. The electrical installation contractor will re-inspect, on a sample basis, those items previously installed for which there is no auditable evidence that the applicable requirements from manufacturer's

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instructions/manuals had been followed. YAEC will perform surveillance on this re-inspection. The inspection results will be reviewed by the installation contractor and YAEC to determine the necessity for additional rework/inspection.

It is expected that the above-listed actions will be completed by September 1, 1982.
