Haddam Neck Plant
Inadvertent Omission of Licensing Fee

The referenced letter transmitted four proposed Technical Specification changes for NRC review and approval. Pursuant to 10CFR170, Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company (CYAPCO) determined that Items 1, 2 and 3 of the Technical Specification changes constitute one Class II Amendment while Item 4 of the Technical Specification change constitutes a Class III Amendment. CYPACO therefore proposed a licensing fee of \$5,200 which was inadvertently omitted from the transmittal package.

Upon review of this matter CYAPCO verified that the fourth item of Reference (1) is a change to Appendix B, Environmental Technical Specifications. In discussions with the NRC Staff, it was revealed that the Staff would no longer review changes to Appendix B other than those associated with the Radiological Effluent Technical Specifications and deletions to the ETS. The Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board ruling of December 27, 1978 (Yellow Creek, ASLAB-515) was cited as justification for this position. As such, the NRC is requested to disregard this item in the scope of review.
