SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 030-28823/94-01

This refers to the routine, unannounced inspection conducted by Mr. Mark R. Shaffer of this office on February 22, 1994. The inspection included a review of activities authorized by Byproduct Materials License 42-01368-04. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with members of your staff.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the condition of the license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews of personnel, independent measurements, and observation of activities in progress.

No violations or deviations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter is required.

The inspection disclosed that the licensee possessed several sealed sources containing microcurie quantities of byproduct material which were used for academic instruction. Additionally, the licensee received microcurie amounts of technetium-99m to be used for removable contamination exercises. The inspector noted that the licensee's radiation safety committee provided sufficient oversight of program activities, and records of were adequate for the size and scope of the radiation safety program.


