Dear Mr. DeYoung:

Please find attached Florida Power Corporation's response to the Notice of Violation in Inspection Report 50-302/82-25 and the Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty relating to the violations. Florida Power Corporation has reviewed the records of those incidents and does not dispute the material information contained in the inspection report. Therefore, a check for \$50,000 (Fifty Thousand Dollars) is attached and is remitted as required by 10 CFR 2.205(b) and the NRC Enforcement Policy 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982).

As requested by the letter dated December 27, 1982 from J. P. O'Reilly (Regional Administrator, Region II) to J. A. Hancock (Vice President, Nuclear Operations, FPC), we have reviewed our management controls in this area and do not consider them deficient. However, as noted in the response, we have strengthened procedural controls in related areas to prevent recurrence. Furthermore, Florida Power Corporation has taken many actions to heighten employee/contractor awareness throughout our organization of the need for absolute procedural compliance and the consequences of failure to do so. Florida Power Corporation remains committed to assuring that the Security Program at Crystal River Unit 3 is properly managed.


