NOTICE OF VIOLATION

South Suburban Hospital

License No. 12-15191-01

As a result of the inspection conducted on January 24, 1983, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, 47 FR 998. (March 9, 1982), the following violation was identified:

License Condition No. 14 requires that all license material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated June 24, 1977. Item No. 14 of the application, states that Medical Isotope Committee meetings will be held on a quarterly basis.


Contrary to the above requirement, the NRC inspector learned through statements by licensee representatives and a review of records, that this requirement is not being met. Specifically, no meetings were held between June 15, 1981 and December 14, 1981 and between June 21, 1982 and October 11, 1982. These are intervals in excess of the quarterly frequency requirement.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
