 SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING HELD ON FEBRUARY 24, 1994,
 TO DISCUSS LICENSING ISSUES

On February 24, 1994, NRC staff members met at Rockville, Maryland, with employees of Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI) to discuss the status of licensing issues at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant. A list of attendees is included as an enclosure.

At the meeting, the priorities and schedules for Perry's licensing issues were discussed. There was general agreement between the NRC staff and CEI regarding the top ten issues for resolution. Specific issues desired by Perry to support work during or startup from the current refuel outage are the main steam line radiation monitors scram and valve isolation signal removal, and the recently submitted In-Service Test Program relief requests. The NRC staff stated that both reviews are scheduled for completion in April 1994.

The NRC staff requested a telecon be held regarding the submittal concerning instrumentation surveillance test intervals and allowed outage times, and the staff requested a schedule for the submittal of a revised response to GL 91-11. CEI agreed to both of those requests. Also, the NRC staff stated that Supplement 6 to Generic Letter 89-10 will be issued soon, and any request for extension of motor-operated valve testing should comply with the supplement. The meeting ended with both parties agreeing to maintain good communications.
