## APPENDIX A

## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Presbyterian University of Pennsylvania Medical Center Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19104 Docket No. 030-02942 License No. 39-00168-06

As a result of the inspection conducted on January 14, 1983, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C), the following violation was identified:

Condition 18 of License No. 37-00168-06 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in an application dated September 2, 1977, and letters dated December 20, 1977, June 8, 1978; an application dated December 20, 1978; and a letter dated August 24, 1981.

Item 9 of the letter dated December 20, 1977, requires that technicians who draw up and inject radioactive material wear disposable gloves and lab coats.

Contrary to the above, on January 14, 1983, neither disposable gloves nor a lab coat were worn during the injection of radioactive material.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Presbyterian-University of Pennsylvania Medical Center is hereby required to submit to this office within 30 days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including; (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending this response time.
