This confirms our telephone conversation of 01 and 07 February 1983 as relates to my objection to the proposed change of schedule submitted by the Applicant on 21 January 1983.



On a different matter; it was noted that your memorandum and order number 81-49-01 OL, dated 07 December 1982, omitted rulings on my contentions number 16, 17, 18, 19, and 20.

Staff Counsel Goddard and I made this discovery during a discussion relating to contentions at a meeting in Jefferson City, Missouri on 08 February 1982. I am sure he will, also, bring this matter to your attention upon his return to Washington, D.C.
