# JOINT MOTION OF NRC STAFF AND INDIANA UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE FOR ADOPTION OF HEARING SCHEDULE AND STATEMENT OF ISSUES

The NRC staff (Staff) and the Indiana University School of Medicine (Licensee) jointly move the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board) to adopt the following proposed hearing schedule and statement of issues.

- The schedule may be shortened or enlarged upon the filing of motions for good cause shown.

### Statement of Issues

The Staff and Licensee agree that the issues to be considered at the hearing shall be as

set out at page 2 of the Board's "Memorandum and Order (Hearing Request)" issued on March

11, 1994. For convenience these issues are set out below:

(1) Whether the Licensee was in violation of the Commission's requirements set forth in the written notice of violation and proposed imposition of civil penalty served on the Licensee on October 7, 1993; (2) Whether, on the basis of such violation, the Order Imposing Civil Monetary Penalty should be sustained.

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# Prehearing Conference

In light of the agreement on scheduling and issues reached by the Staff and Licensee, both parties agree that a prehearing conference is not necessary at this time. In the event that the Board determines that it is necessary to hold a prehearing conference at this time, the parties suggest that such a conference could be held on the record by telephone.

### Conclusion

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The Staff and Licensee jointly move the Board to adopt the hearing schedule and statement of issues set forth above.
