PETITION TO AMEND CONTENTIONS"


On August 25, 1982, Del-Aware filed by express mail an "Application for Approval of Petition to Amend Contentions". Pursuant to 10 CFR §§2.730(C) and 2.710, the Applicant's and Staff's responses would be due to be filed on September 7 and 13, respectively.

Our ruling on Del-Aware's request could affect the water issues, on which testimony will be filed on September 20. The hearing will begin on October 4. Accordingly, the Board ordered that responses to
