On September 1, 1982, TMIA filed motions requesting (1) an extension of time for filing its brief in support of exceptions and a waiver of the page limitation and (2) a suspension of briefing on its exceptions regarding safetyrelated maintenance practices. On September 2, we ordered parties having objections to TMIA's motions to inform us by Thursday, September 9.

Today, we received a motion from intervenor Marjorie M. Aamodt requesting, in essence, a suspension of the briefing schedule. The basis of the request is an alleged incident of uncontrolled radiation worker training examinations, discussed in a recent Board Notification (BN-82-84 (August 17, 1982)).
