ORDER

September 7, 1982

On September 1, 1982, TMIA filed motions requesting (1) an extension of time for filing its brief in support of exceptions and a waiver of the page limitation and (2) a suspension of briefing on its exceptions regarding safety-related maintenance practices. On September 2, we ordered parties having objections to TMIA's motions to inform us by Thursday, September 9.

Today, we received a motion from intervenor Marjorie M. Aamodt requesting, in essence, a suspension of the briefing schedule. The basis of the request is an alleged incident of uncontrolled radiation worker training examinations, discussed in a recent Board Notification (BN-82-84 (August 17, 1982)). In an attached motion filed with the Licensing Board, the Aamodts



seek reopening of the record and hearing on this matter. Before us, they seek deferral of briefing until this issue is resolved.

We telephoned all parties today to advise them that they should address Mrs. Aamodt's motion as part of their September 9 filings with us. By this Order we confirm that parties having objections to Mrs. Aamodt's motion should so inform us, in writing, no later than close of business, Thursday, September 9, 1982.
