
Dear Mr. Boehnert:

I have reviewed the collection of the subject Consultants' Comments on W AP600 Test Programs and the transcripts of our round-table discussion. I have concluded that Westinghouse has not resolved the vast majority of issues raised by the consultants, and the round-table discussion was premature.

Westinghouse has collected and categorized forty-nine comments, but there are a number of issues still repeated in that collection. Of the forty-nine comments, only one administrative (identification of RELAP5 version to be used) and two technical questions (namely SPES Scaling Comment No.2, and ADS Analysis Comment No.9) have been answered. Westinghouse promised to furnish the answers to the remaining questions at a later date, notably after completion of the OSU Scaling Report.

These answers will have to be reviewed by the Subcommittee. I propose that Westinghouse provide the answers in writing, and that the Subcommittee can review the answers prior to the meeting at which the Westinghouse response is scheduled for discussion.
