IMPACT OF PROPOSED LICENSE FEE SCHEDULE REVISIONS ON DATA

COLLECTION SYSTEM

In your letter dated August 5, 1981 concerning the above subject, you indicated that if we revised the fee schedule to assess inspection fees for reactors and major fuel cycle facilities on an actual manpower basis that adding the requirement to record manpower by report number would place a sizeable burden on the inspectors as well as the MPS system, forms, etc. You suggest as an alternative to list the inspection reports issued during the billing period for each docket if the licensee questions the bill.

We have no objection to this alternative and are willing to try it if the Commission adopts the revised method of billing for certain inspections. However, we wish to point out that our acceptance is contingent upon the Commission's ability to adequately respond to questions raised by the licensee concerning the manpower expended for certain inspections. If the Commission adopts the revised system and if licensees insist that the manpower assessed be identified by specific report before payment is made, then I think your office should move toward revising the MPS system in order that the manpower can be identified by the specific report.
