DRAFT NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING RE LICENSE

FEE SCHEDUL.

We have reviewed the subject draft and offer the following comments:

Page 4, Third Paragraph

For clarity, delete the fourth and fifth lines and after the word "add" and insert the following, "the inflation factor (used in formulating the budgets for FY 1978-FY 1981) for all other allocated costs."

Page 11, Last Paragraph

Delete the word "concur" and insert the words "have coordinated."

It is felt that the offices listed are not in a position to concur in the raising of license fees, but that only the Commission can do so.

These changes have been discussed with Bill Miller's staff.
