SUBJECT: NRC LICENSE FEES

In response to your memorandum of November 5, 1981, subject as above, we are providing the breakdown of OELD time spent in the categories requested:

Office of the Executive Legal Director Allocation(%) to the Following Functions

These percentages were derived as follows:

Workload data for OELD is maintained by each OELD division (Hearing, Regulations, Rulemaking and Enforcement, and Operations and Administration) and monitored by the OELD Program Support Branch. The workload is subdivided by function and expressed in staff years. In most cases a single function is devoted to a single client office; for example the sole client for reactor license applications is the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation.

Each Division's workload was allocated to the proper function as laid out in the November 5 memorandum. Workload figures in each category were then totalled and an overall grand total of staff years for all functions was established.

Using the grand total of staff years as 100% of OELD FY 1981 time spent on these functions, each category was converted from staff years to percentage allocation by dividing each category's staff year figure by the grand total.
