SUBJECT: REVISIONS TO THE PROPOSED LICENSE FEE SCHEDULE

This memorandum confirms our discussion and changes to the proposed fee schedule, as agreed upon in our meeting with you on April 16, 1982. The page numbers listed below correspond with the pages of the fee schedule transmitted by Richard E. Cunningham's March 26, 1982 memorandum to Daniel Donoghue.

Page 1 - Source Material - The category entitled "Use of source material for testing of military munitions" has been eliminated because the licenses affected by this category are issued to Federal (fee-exempt) agencies.

Byproduct Material - Because NMSS no longer reviews applications for use of byproduct material in power sources, the category for "broad scope" manufacturing licenses omits the phrase "except byproduct material for use in power generation."

Page 2 - The first two categories (for licenses issued pursuant to §32.72 and/or 32.73) were amended to include "§32.74" to cover "sources or devices containing byproduct material for medical use."

The category for licenses covering "more than 10,000 curies of byproduct material...for irradiation" should now read "for possession and use of 10,000 curies or more of byproduct material...".

The footnote was amended to read "The total fee will be based on the hours specified plus 28 hours for each device/product review and 5 hours for each sealed source review."

Page 3 - The categories for research and development licenses were amended to delete the phrase "and/or academic purposes."

The staff hours for "broad scope" research and development licenses were amended to read "12" and "2" for renewal and amendment, respectively.

The category for licenses authorizing "services for other licenses, except for leak testing," was amended to read "except for leak testing services and waste disposal pickup services."

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The category for "Licenses which authorize leak testing services for other licensees" was eliminated by combining it with the category entitled "All other specific byproduct material licenses..."; because both categories required the same number of staff-hour review time.

Page 5 - The category for "licenses of broad scope...authorizing research and development..." will be amended to read "Licenses of broad scope issued to medical institutions or two or more physicians pursuant to Parts 30, 33, 35, 40 and 70 of this chapter authorizing research and development for human use...". This will identify this category as relating specifically to medical research and development. In addition, the phrase "and non-human use" has been omitted since industrial research and development is covered by the categories authorizing research and development found on page three. The staff hours for this category were amended to read "12" and "2" for renewal and amendment respectively.
