This letter constitutes an interim report regarding the subject condition, initially reported to the Commission on July 26, 1982, under the requirements of 10CFR50.55(e).

This deficiency has been addressed for Zimmer by a dynamic requalification program which is a combination of analysis and limited scope testing. The program covers qualification of both the back-to-back and single row Hydraulic Control Unit configurations.

The structural analysis portion of the effort has been completed and a formal report was issued to CG&E in June, 1982. Design drawings for the required modifications have been completed. Installation of the HCU modifications will be implemented pending resolution of the current CG&E stop work order #80-14.

The limited scope testing to assure operability of the essential safety-related active components is in the planning stage at the present time. Depending on the availability of the components, it is expected that the testing portion of the work will be complete by the end of October, 1982. The test program will complete the engineering effort required for dynamic requalification of the HCUs for Zimmer. Mr. J. G. If qualification testing is successfully completed by the end of October, a final report will be submitted by November 15, 1982.
