This letter is in regard to the building of an uranium enrichment plant in Forest Grove and Center Springs. I urge you to advise the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ^{Board} to deny the Louisiana Energy Service's request ~~for~~ to build this plant. 300002

Please examine the effect that this hazardous waste ^{site} can have on humans and animals. Polluted water from the plant will be discharged into the Lake Claiborne watershed, 40 homes rely on these wells for their drinking water. Elderly residents are concerned about how rapidly they can

In addition, the Dept. of Energy's is already considering using other technologies to produce uranium which pose no proliferation threat. Also, the cost for LES' uranium is higher than that of DOE's uranium.
