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REQUEST FOR PREFERENCE IN MAILING OF SUBPART I CLEAN AIR ACT INFORMATION (SP-94-006)

Your timely assistance is requested in facilitating a bulk mailing of EPA-developed guidance relative to its Clean Air Act standards of 40 CFR Part 61. NRC has agreed to share this guidance with its licensees in an effort to minimize duplication of agency effort. EPA's standards in Subpart I became effective for most NRC and Agreement State licensees in November 1992. Those licensed facilities which are not exempt from the reporting requirements in Subpart I must submit their first annual report concerning air emissions of radionuclides for calendar year 1993 to EPA by March 31, 1994.

One option for distributing the EPA guidance to Agreement State licensees is for you to provide us with the number of licensees (other than sealed source licensees) who are subject to Subpart I requirements of the Clean Air Act. EPA will then mail you the number of guidance documents you request for your distribution to those licensees.

The second option is for you to provide directly to EPA the mailing labels for those licensees who are subject to the Subpart I requirements. Should you choose this option, mailing labels would have to be provided to the EPA contact (Al Colli, Office of Radiation and Indoor Air, Mail Code 6602J, U.S. EPA, 401 M Street, S.W., Washington, DC 20460) no later than January 24, 1994.
