SUBJECT: INTERIM RELIABILITY EVALUATION PROGRAM (IREP) STUDY OF CRYSTAL RIVER UNIT 3 (CR-3)

We are about to initiate a review of the results of the CR-3 IREP study and upon the completion of our review we plan to prepare and issue a Safety Evaluation on the review. On September 30, 1980 we sent you some recommendations and comments that were an outgrowth of the study for your comment. On November 6, 1980 you provided us with your comments. To assist us with our review of the results of the IREP study we would appreciate it if you would revise your November 6, 1980 responses to reflect your current position with respect to our recommendations and comments. In addition, please include any additional comments you may have on the results of the IREP study that are not included in your November 6, 1980 letter. We would appreciate receiving your responses to this letter within 30 days.

The reporting and/or recordkeeping requirements contained in this letter affect fewer than ten respondents; therefore, OMB clearance is not required under P. L. 96-511.


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
