Subject: TMI-1 IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS DECISION

Discussion: This paper deals with:

- (1) a grant to the parties to the TMI-1 restart proceeding of additional time to comment on the GPU v. B&W litigation material;
- (2) staff's proposal to "revalidate" its position on management competence; and
- (3) additional motions by the Aamodts, one of the parties to the proceeding.

1. Extension of Time for Comment

On March 16, 1983, the Docketing and Service Branch notified the parties to the restart proceeding that they would be given an opportunity to comment on the staff's analysis of the GPU v. B&W transcripts. The notice gave them fifteen days from service of staff's analysis to comment. Staff's analysis was served on March 29. Several parties commented by April 20, 1983.
