

6. EXPLOPE AGREEMENTS TO GROUP WITNESSES IN PANELS AND

LIMITATIONS ON CROSS-EXAMINATION.

7. RECOMMEND ELIMINATION OF TESTIMONY THAT IS ARGUMENTATIVE,

CUMULATIVE, REPETITIVE OR IRRELEVANT.

8. AFTER REDUCING TESTIMONY AND CROSS-EXAMINATION TO A
MINIMUM CONSISTENT WITH THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF A COMPLETE AND
RELIABLE RECORD ON THE CONTENTIONS UNDER COMMISSION QUESTIONS
