Oral argument on the appeal of Consumers Power Company from the Licensing Board's October 29, 1982, partial initial decision (concerning the neutron multiplication factor) in this spent fuel pool expansion proceeding will be held at 9:30 a.m., on Thursday, March 24, 1983, in the NRC Public Hearing Room, Fifth Floor, East-West Towers Building, 4350 East-West Highway, Bethesda, Maryland. 
