Discussion:

On February 2, 1983 the Commission met in a session, closed under Exemption 5 of the Sunshine Act, to discuss proposed penalties involving the Brunswick station. Accordingly, the transcript of that meeting has been withheld pending this review by OGC. Shortly after the meeting, the staff proposed to impose a civil penalty on the licensee for the violations discussed with the Commission. The staff recently decided to deny the licensee's request for mitigation and imposed the penalty. The licensee has not decided whether to contest the penalty. In these circumstances, we believe
