

Subject: Amendment to export license XSNM 1912

Dear Mr. Griffin,

This is to amend the quantities of materials appearing in our letter of February 11, 1982.

The actual amounts of uranium to be exported under license XSNM-1912 are now the following:

928.25 kg of  $\rm U_{235}$  contained in 28,600 kg of total uranium (instead of 471.25 kg of  $\rm U_{235}$  contained in 14,500 kg of total uranium) plus 1 kg of the same material, as sample, containing 0.033 kg of  $\rm U_{235}$ .

The other data of our February 11, 1982 letter remain unchanged.
