SUBJECT: REUTER-STOKES REQUEST TO EXPORT ADDITIONAL 40 IN-CORE
DETECTORS (XCOM0479-AMENDMENT 1)

By letter dated February 9, 1983 Reuter-Stokes requested an amendment to export license XCOM0479 to allow for the export of 40 additional in-core neutron detectors for use in Forsmark I and II. The licensee advised that the 40 units are urgently needed and are scheduled to be shipped on February 22, 1983.

The staff has determined that the export 1) meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and the U.S. NRC rules and regulations, Title 10, Chapter 1, Part 110, 2) will not be inimical to the common defense and security, and 3) does not constitute an unreasonable risk to the public health and safety.

Due to the urgency expressed by Reuter-Stokes, the license is being issued without the customary 15-day waiting period. This exemption is based on 110.10(a) of Part 110.
