
Enclosed please find two applications to permit the export of 26,000 kilograms of uranium enriched to 3.30 weight percent U-235 and of nuclear fuel hardware in the amount of \$1,946,300 for one of the EDF reactors in France.

These materials are to be exported to Exxon Nuclear GmbH in Lingen, West Germany for fabrication into complete fuel assemblies. Any excess or damaged  $UO_2$  pellets accumulated at the Lingen facility will be returned to Richland, Washington, U.S.A. for recovery.

The SNM will be packaged in Model CE-250-2 or BB-250-2 shipping containers (Certificate of Competent Authority Nos. USA/9022/AF and USA/5768/AF, respectively) when exported for fuel assembly at Exxon Nuclear GmbH.
