General Atomic Company (GA) makes application, pursuant to 10 CFR 110, for export license amendment to cover shipment of special nuclear, source and byproduct materials, and thorium to KFA, Julich, West Germany. We request that the license be amended to increase amount of U-235 to 50 gms contained in up to 93% enriched uranium, and the amount of thorium to 500 grams. We also request that the expiration date be extended for a three year period.
