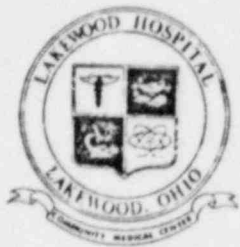

- I. Technetium 99m - Labeled albumin microspheres - 100 millicuries
- J. Technetium 99m - DTPA (Squibb) - 50 millicuries
- K. Technetium 99m - Mallinckrodt Sulfur Colloid Kit, in addition to Squibb kit already approved - 100 millicuries

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
