SUBJECT: IP REQUEST FOR EXPERT REVIEW OF KRSKC S/G CHANGES

This confirms our discussions regarding NRR staff experts review of the KRSKO Nuclear Power Plant steam generator modifications. First, per a request from IP, the review should be conducted in the near future by a group of staff acting as experts, rather than as an official NRC review. We should attempt to complete on or before June 25 as requested but should not allow this effort at this time to interfere with any other NRR high priority work.

Secondly, the effort (resources) expended by NRR staff should be minimized and should not exceed two man months. Since the plant modifications are mostly systems oriented, the major activity of this effort will fall in DSI. I note however that much of this review would need to be completed in any event in connection with our D-4 S/G Design review on OL licensing reviews now underway (e.g., Byron and Comanche Peak).

In order to properly manage and account for the time expended, the Project Manager for integrating this effort, Bill Kane, will issue a TAC number for this activity. He will transmit any questions we have and our final comments directly to J. LaFleur of International Programs.
