AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-29
AMENDMENT NO. 13

Indemnity Agreement No. B-29, between Nuclear Fuel Services, Inc., (NFS), the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (the Authority), and the Atomic Energy Commission (the Commission), dated May 27, 1965, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

1. Effective as of September 16, 1982, the date the Nuclear Regulatory Commission terminated NFS's authority under the license, the term "Licensee" as used in this Indemnity Agreement shall thereafter refer only to the Authority, and, except as provided in paragraph 2 below, NFS shall no longer be a party to this Indemnity Agreement.


2. This amendment shall not affect any obligation of NFS, the Authority, or NRC with respect to any nuclear incident occurring prior to the time of transfer of the location to the U.S. Department of Energy pursuant to License Amendment No. 31.


