Gentlemen:

We have reviewed your application dated October 10, 1974 concerning a license to manufacture and distribute iridium-192 wire in nylon ribbon for medical use by persons licensed pursuant to Section 35.14 of 10 CFR 35. While the application has been filed under Section 32.72 dealing with radiopharmaceuticals, Section 32.74, 10 CFR 32 dealing with distribution of sealed sources for medical use should apply.

Even though your letter is dated before October 15, 1974 (the specified deadline date under Section 32.74, paragraph C), Howard Hospital Supply Corporation is reminded that distribution to persons licensed pursuant to Section 35.14 of 10 CFR 35 is not authorized until licensing actions are completed, since your application was received by messenger on April 15, 1975.

To continue review of the iridium-192 wire, the following information should be submitted pursuant to 32.74(a)(2) through (3).

1. Specific model identification of the Ir-192 nylon ribbon sources.
2. Items B, C, D, E and F of the enclosed guide entitled "Information to be Submitted Concerning Sealed Sources Containing Radioactive Material."

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We will be pleased to continue review of the MHSC application upon receipt of the above information. Please refer to application Control No. 55796 in your reply.
