Subject: INDIAN POINT EMERGENCY PLANNING: POSSIBLE
COURSES OF ACTION

Purpose: To discuss options for responding to FEMA's recent
assessment of the state of emergency preparedness
for accidents at Indian Point.

Discussion: In the Commission's December 22, 1982 order
declining to take enforcement action at that time
regarding emergency planning at Indian Point, it
stressed that an emergency exercise would be held
in March, 1983; that FEMA would be providing an
analysis of the exercise in April, 1983; and that
it would revisit the issue after receiving FEMA's
views.

The Commission has now heard from FEMA, which
finds emergency planning inadequate, owing
principally to continuing serious deficiencies.

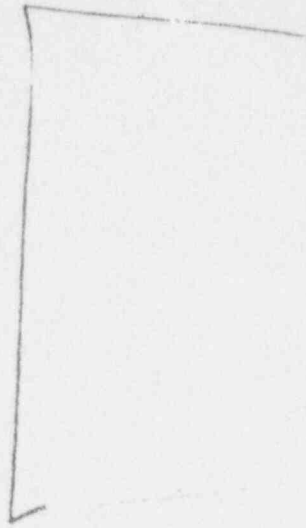
