

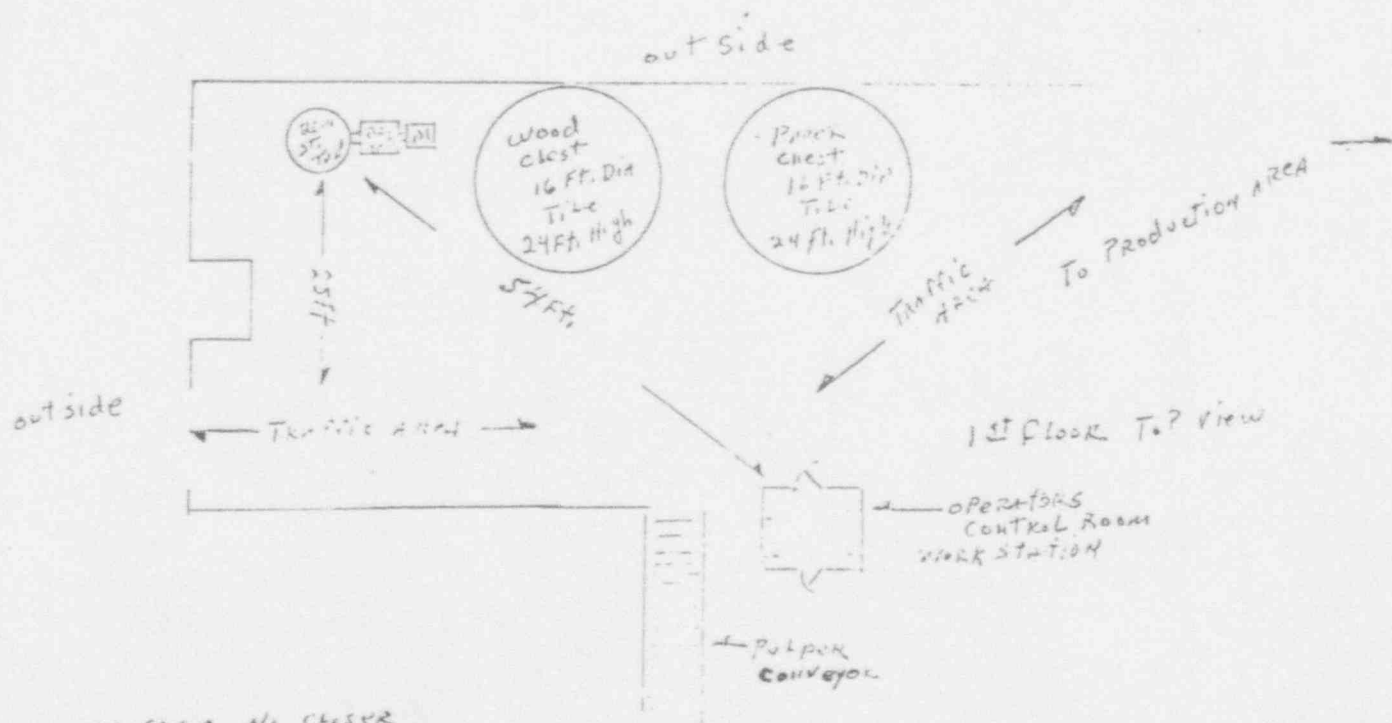
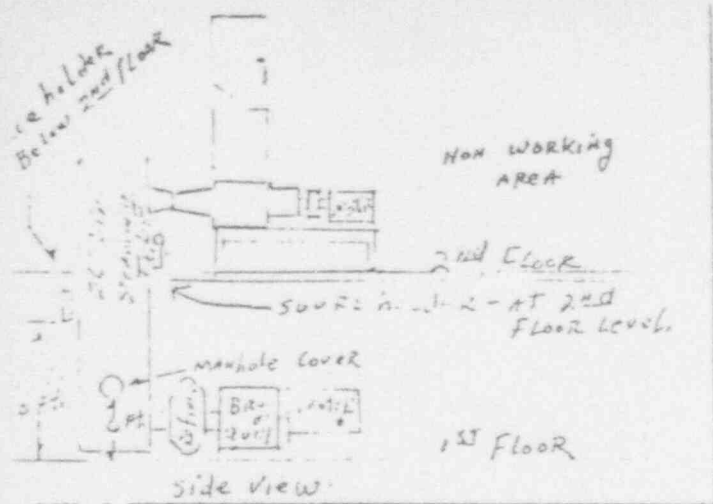
The Radiation Protection Officer will be responsible for the supervision, control, and use of the licensed material at all times. He will also be responsible to insure that the lock-out procedures and safety procedures are followed and will maintain control of the keys to the source holders and access cover. His responsibilities include insuring that the licensed sources are leak tested in a timely manner as per NRC regulations.
