SUBJECT: REQUALIFICATION PROGRAM INSPECTION - JAMES A. FITZPATRICK

In a telephone conversation on March 25, 1994, Mr. A. Burritt and Mr. F. Catella made arrangements for the NRC to inspect the licensed operator requalification program at the James A. FitzPatrick Nuclear Power Plant. The inspection is planned for the week of May 16, 1994, which coincides with your regularly-scheduled requalification examination cycle. The staff at your facility should prepare and conduct the requalification examinations in accordance with your NRC-approved requalification program.

In accordance with 10 CFR 55.59(c), the NRC may request facility licensees to submit their comprehensive requalification written examinations or annual operating tests as necessary to support the NRC's inspection program needs. In order for the NRC to adequately prepare for this inspection, please furnish the operating tests scheduled for the week of the inspection to the NRC by April 20, 1994. Mr. Catella has been advised of this request and provided with the name and address of the NRC lead inspector assigned to this inspection.

The request for requalification examination material is covered by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Clearance Number 3150-0101, which expires on October 31, 1995. The estimated average burden is 4.0 hours per response, including gathering, copying, and mailing the required material. Send comments regarding this burden estimate or any other aspect of this collection of information, including suggestions for reducing this burden, to the Information and Records Management Branch, MNBB-7714, Division of Information Support Services, Office of Information Resources Management, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, D.C. 20555; and to the Paperwork Reduction Project (3150-0101), Office of Information and Regulatory Affairs, NEOB-3019, Office of Management and Budget, Washington, D.C. 20503.
