Dear Messrs. Mullins and Hall:

Please be advised that Atlas has conducted an annual survey of land use within a two mile area of the mill. This survey is in accordance with License Condition No. 47 of our Source Material License SUA-917. There have been some changes in the land use within this area during the past year. The differences are described below:

#### Residences

One new residence is under construction (SE 1-2 mile quadrant).

#### Grazing

Grazing has continued in the ESE half mile quadrant. Approximately 30 head of cattle were grazing in this quadrant during the winter months.

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Gardens

There was one family garden in the ESE 1-2 mile quadrant.

Industry

Construction is underway in the ESE 1-2 mile quadrant for a Recreation Vehicle Park.

Wells

No new wells have been constructed.


