The Commission has granted the enclosed exemption regarding your request of February 10, 1994, requesting a one-time exemption from the requirements of 10 CFR 26.21(b) in order to extend the time requirement for Fitness-For-Duty refresher training.

Section 26.21(b) of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations states that refresher training must be completed on a nominal 12-month frequency or more frequently where the need is indicated. As a one-time exemption associated with the specific case addressed in the February 10, 1994, request, this exemption would allow the refresher training time requirement to be extended to approximately 21 months.


