The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 73 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-21 for Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit 1, in response to your application dated November 22, 1993, as supplemented March 4, 1994.

The amendment revises the Technical Specifications by clarifying the operability requirements relative to the design function of the scram discharge volume - water level high rod block. In addition, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company is adding a statement which defines operability and surveillance requirements for the rod block functions while the reactor mode selector switch is in the REFUEL or SHUTDOWN positions.
