SUBJECT. PHYSICAL SECURITY INSPECTION AT THE BYRON STATION

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. G. L. Pirtle of this office between February 16 and March 2 1994. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for the Byron Nuclear Power Station facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations of activities in progress.

No violations of NRC requirements were noted. A concern was noted pertaining to the lack of training and procedural guidance for an important security function. Your staff has agreed to address this concern. Aggressive self assessment of the security program was evident since the previous inspection and was a contributing factor in the good performance noted during the inspection.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy if this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
