Sub- ct: SEVEN ARRESTED DURING DEMONSTRATION AT FERMI 2

On March 28, 1994 at 4:00 p.m. (EST), there was a planned demonstration held at the Fermi 2 Nuclear Power Station to mark the 15th anniversary of the Three Mile Island event.

At approximately 5:40 p.m., seven demonstrators were arrested by the local sheriff's department from in front of an alternate plant gate. The demonstrators sat on the road, blocked traffic, and refused to move.

Approximately thirty people participated in the demonstration, which ended at 6:50 p.m. (EST).

The resident inspector informed Region III (Chicago) of the demonstration on March 28, 1994. Region III (Chicago) security specialists monitored the licensee's activities and established communication with the licensee.

There was area media coverage of the event.

The State of Michigan will be informed. The information in this preliminary notification has been reviewed with licensee management.
