SUBJECT: REQUALIFICATION PROGRAM EVALUATION REPORT NO. 50-213/90-10 (OL-RQ)

On June 5 - 8, 1990, the NRC administered requalification examinations to employees of your company who operate the Haddam Neck Power Plant. The evaluation was conducted in accordance with Revision 5 (1/1/89), to NUREG-1021, Operator Licensing Examiner Standards, ES-601, "Administration of NRC Requalification Program Evaluations." The evaluation had two purposes, evaluation of the effectiveness of the licensed operator requalification training program at maintaining the competency of the licensed operators, and examination of the individual operators to determine if they would satisfy the regulatory requirement of passing an NRC administered examination prior to license renewal. At the conclusion of the examination/evaluation, any generic findings that evolved as a result of the examination were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

As a result of this evaluation, your requalification program has been assigned an overall program rating of satisfactory. As evaluated by the NRC, all twelve operators passed all parts of the examination. These evaluations were conducted in accordance with the criteria of NUREG 1021, ES-601, noted above.


Also, replacement retake examinations were administered to two individuals on May 24, 1990, during the requalification examination preparation week. Both individuals successfully passed their respective segments of the retake examinations. The results of these retakes, one SRO simulator and one SRO written, are detailed within the enclosed report.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
