NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on August 29, 1990, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, (1989) (Enforcement Policy) the following violation was identified:

License Condition 17 requires that all licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations and procedures contained in application dated May 22, 1987.

Application dated May 22, 1987, named an individual as the Radiation Safety Officer.

Contrary to the above, the individual named in the license application is not the Radiation Safety Officer. The company's President assumed the duties of the Radiation Safety Officer in 1987, but the license had not been amended to show this charge.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement V1).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for the violation: (1) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved; (2) the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
