SECOND RESPONSE TO NOTICE OF VIOLATION, LICENSE # 21-01443-06, DOCKET # 030-04794

Dear Mr. Caniano:

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In response to the June 29, 1990 Notice Of Violation concerning eating and drinking in restricted areas the following actions have been taken.

- As described in our July 24 letter, senior management in each department was notified and asked to take appropriate actions to prevent further violations in their areas. The senior managers have informed they staff of the infraction and instructed them to comply with the no eating and drinking rule.
- Senior mangers have also instituted audit procedures to monitor the restricted areas for infractions. Department supervisors or the department's Safety Committee will conduct quarterly inspections of restricted areas and inform department managers of any problems found and corrective actions taken.
- 3. The RSO will look for infractions during the quarterly radiation safety audits required by our License. Department managements will be inform if problems are found and the RSO will request written notification of corrective actions.
