Enclosed is a letter from Westinghouse Electric Corporation, dated September 12, 1990, requesting an amendment to export license XCOM1032, to 1) increase the quantity of mechanical plugs authorized for export from 2,000 to 10,000; and 2) extend the expiration date from September 30, 1992 to December 31, 1995.

Before taking action on this request, we would appreciate your obtaining necessary assurances under Section 109 of the Act and receiving your views from the overall perspective of the Executive Branch, as to whether the proposed amendment meets the other applicable criteria in the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 as amended by the Nuclear Nonproliferation Act of 1978.
