Enclosed is a letter from Westinghouse Electric Corporation, dated September 12, 1990, requesting an amendment to export license XCOM1032, to 1) increase the quantity of mechanical plugs authorized for export from 2,000 to 10,000; and 2) extend the expiration date from September 30, 1992 to December 31, 1995.
