Emergency Preparedness Appraisal Confirmation of Action

Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

By letter dated June 30, 1982, Florida Power Corporation committed to provide you with our resolution of the meteorological tower study which indicated the 10 meter instrumentation is influenced by the nearby coal pile. The evaluation has been completed and the following actions will be taken.

A new meteorological tower will be erected west of Crystal River Units 1 and 2 and will utilize comparable instrumentation to that available on the existing tower for determination of offsite doses. The present tower will be utilized as a backup system. A schedule for procurement and installation will be provided to you as soon as it is developed and approved by Florida Power Corporation management.
