Within the scope of this i vestigation, no violations or deviations were disclosed. However, while no evidence of forgery was obtained, the investigative findings give us cause for concern about the adequacy of your hanger inspection documentation program. Accordingly, this matter is identified as an Unresolved Item (82-23-01) pending further inspection.
